4) FIRST AID MEASURES

4.1. Description of first aid measures

Inhalation: If the person has difficulty to breathe, remove person to fresh air and at a rest in a position comfortable for breathing. If the problem persists, consult a doctor.

5) FIREFIGHTING MEASURES

5.1. Extinguishing media

Suitable extinguishing media:

This product is non-flammable, but its packaging may be combustible. Use foam, carbon dioxide, or powder fire extinguishers.

5.2. Special hazards arising from the substance or mixture

Hazardous combustion products: Fire causes formation of toxic gases. Carbon dioxide, carbon monoxide.

5.3. Advice for firefighters

Special firefighting methods:

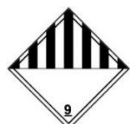
